



GENERAL ADMISSION UPDATE – 11.12.2020

2021 marks the 75th anniversary of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. As we celebrate the legacy of golf and giving throughout Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz counties, we realize that things will look a little different at the tournament this year.

Like most events in our daily lives, tournament plans have been adjusted in response to the challenges of COVID-19. The safety and well-being of our guests, partners, vendors, volunteers, PGA TOUR professionals, caddies, their families, and our community is our top priority. We have been working closely with the PGA TOUR as well as local officials to determine what our event will look like in February.

As of November 12, 2020, Monterey County remains in a tier that will not permit live audiences at professional sporting events in the State of California. Given that, we cannot release general admission tickets at this time. When we get closer to the event and can better assess the COVID-19 status of Monterey County, we will be able to make a final determination on making general admission tickets available to the public.
