The Chevron Challenge benefits youth-serving nonprofits in Monterey County with a focus on access, bridging the digital divide, STEM education and serving underrepresented communities and youth.

Five teams, each comprised of an athlete and a PGA Tour professional, competed in a 5-hole putting contest

- Modified alternate shot
- Both contestants putt on each hole and then decide which shot to play
- Alternate team member hits second shot and they continue to alternate until putt is holed

The athlete/PGA TOUR professional teams included Mia Hamm with D.A. Points, Manolo Vega with Brandt Snedeker, Steve Young with Vaughn Taylor, Larry Fitzgerald with Nick Taylor and Canelo Alvarez and Jimmy Walker. The Fitzgerald and Taylor duo claimed victory with a score of 12.
