PGA TOUR Professionals and athletes from the world of sports compete for \$250,000 for charity.

The Chevron Challenge benefits youth-serving nonprofits in Monterey County with a focus on access, bridging the digital divide, STEM education and serving underrepresented communities and youth.

Five teams, each comprised of an athlete and a PGA Tour professional, competed in a 5-hole putting contest

- Modified alternate shot
- Both contestants putt on each hole and then decide which shot to play
- Alternate team member hits second shot and they continue to alternate until putt is holed

The athlete/PGA TOUR professional teams included Alex Smith with Austin Smotherman, Buster Posey with Harry Higgs, Josh Allen with Keith Mitchell, Steve Young and Tom Hoge, Aaron Rodgers and Kelly Kraft.

Aces for Access selected charities each received \$50,000: YMCA Central Coast, Girls Inc. of the Central Coast, Boys and Girls Club of Monterey County, Lyceum, and Greenfield Community Science Workshop.

The results were:

- Hole #1 (halved) – Four of the five teams had 2's
- Hole #2 (ace) – Smith/Smotherman
- Hole #3 (halved) – Three of the five teams had 2's
- Hole #4 (2) – Allen/Mitchell
- Hole #5 (halved) - Three of the five teams had 2's
- Play-off on Hole #1 – closest to the pin (Allen/Mitchell)
